RENANIM SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM

Throughout the summer the children will spend a lot of time outdoors frolicking in the water, learning new sports, and enjoying our private, outdoor playground. In our centrally air-conditioned building the children will be doing arts & crafts, singing, cooking, and simply having a wonderful time within the context of a developmentally appropriate educational setting. Special events and special visitors will enhance our program consisting of the following themes that we will explore over the summer.

Session 1 - June 30th through July 25th

Week 1 - Friendship/Safety/Independence Day

We will celebrate the Red, White and Blue-making American flags, singing patriotic songs, and cutting fruit salad from strawberries, blueberries, and bananas. We will talk about how to make new friends by including our newest campers in our activities, by sharing our toys and games, and by reading and discussing stories such as *Will I have a Friend?*

Week 2 - Sand and Sea

We will learn about the plants and animals that inhabit the ocean and live in the sand. We will examine sea shells and other things that we find in the sand. We will investigate discover the properties of sand and water. Our art projects, music and story time will center around sand and sea.

Week 3 - Camping and Hiking

We will talk about camping out-of-doors in parks, campgrounds, the woods, and backyards. The children will become aware of camping activities and learn about items and equipment that are commonly used while camping. Some of our activities will include setting up our dramatic play areas with tents and sleeping bags, singing around a pretend campfire; going on hikes in the woods, preparing foods that are eaten while camping, and cleaning up after camping. The highlight of the week for the older children will be a "Yellow Bus" trip.

Week 4 - Israel's 60th Birthday

We will take an imaginary trip to Israel where we will explore the major cities and attractions. We will learn about kibbutzim and moshavs. We will enjoy Israeli culture and music, and eat Israeli foods. Our art projects and story time will center around Israeli themes. The highlight of the week will be a birthday party for Israel.

Session 2 - July 28th - August 22nd

Week 1 - Dinosaurs

Children love dinosaurs and are impressed by their huge size. Dinosaurs conjure up a prehistoric time when they roamed the earth and there were no people. We will identify the different types of dinosaurs, learn about fossils and visit the dinosaur wing in the Museum of Natural History.

Week 2 - Bugs and Insects

Having talked about large creatures the previous week, we will now focus on some smaller creatures that inhabit the earth. We will learn about lady bugs, caterpillars, and other insects that share our environment. Using the popular children's author, Eric Carle for inspiration, we will create our own bugs and insects. We will read many books by Eric Carle.

Week 3 - Exploring Outer Space

Children are curious about what lies beyond earth and up in the sky. We will talk about the sun the moon and the stars. Like the characters in "Little Einsteins", we will take an imaginary ride in a rocket ship to explore the universe.

Week 4 - Carnival

We will celebrate the final week of camp with a 5-day carnival! The children will have the opportunity to dress up in costumes, make masks and hats, and carnival decorations. Brazilian music will pipe through the school. A clown will visit the camp to entertain the children.
